5. Comprehensive Release. I do hereby, on behalf of myself and my heirs, executors, administrators, assigns and legal and personal representatives, unconditionally and irrevocably release and discharge the Pistols & Pearls Society, the Pistols & Pearls Society's successors, assigns, owners, shareholders, directors, officers, employees, club officers, range masters, match directors, appointed safety officers, agents, representatives, attorneys, independent contractors, subsidiaries, and affiliates and each, every and all persons acting by, through, under or in concert with any of them (collectively, "Released Parties"). I further do hereby on behalf of myself and my heirs, executors, administrators, assigns and legal and personal representatives agree not to sue, or otherwise initiate legal, equitable or similar action or to otherwise file a complaint or other action for controversy resolution or otherwise seek losses, costs or expenses of any nature whatsoever, known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, fixed or contingent, including without limitation, wrongful death, and any and all personal injuries, known or unknown, and death and/or personal injuries to third parties, and injuries to property, real or personal, known or unknown, against any of the Released Parties, caused by any reason whatsoever related to Pistols & Pearls Society and my sport shooting on or about the Pistols & Pearls Society's premises and/or facilities. I also agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against all claims, losses, damages, and costs caused by, arising out of, or related to the actions of myself and those guests for whose conduct I am responsible. This Release shall pertain to any claims which were known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated at the time of the execution of this Agreement, including any information of any nature which, if known by me on the date of execution of this Agreement, may have materially affected my decision to execute this Agreement and specifically this Release.

6. Indemnity. I hereby indemnify, without qualification or limitation, the Released Parties and defend and hold the Released Parties harmless from and against any and all claims, causes of action, demands or charges of every kind and nature, which any third party or person may claim to have or to hold for property damage or personal injuries or any other damages including death, arising from any cause or reason, of every kind and nature pertaining to this Agreement originating from my relationship with any of the Released Parties and any activity directly or indirectly arising from or contemplated by this Agreement.

7. <u>Additional Regulations</u>. I understand that hearing and eye protection (even while using a scope) are mandatory at all Pistols and Pearls Society shooting areas for all persons at all times. I agree that I will not fire or discharge any firearm or gun except in areas so designated by Pistols and Pearls Society or designated instructor.

PISTOLS AND PEARLS SOCIETY RANGE RULES

Shooting Firearms is an inherently dangerous sport. Because of the dangers involved in shooting firearms, we must follow safety rules while handling any firearm, at all times. These range rules are for the safety of yourself and all participants at any event sponsored by Pistols and Pearls.

Pistols and Pearls has a <u>ZERO TOLERANCE</u> policy on violations of range rules. Any violation of a range rule could result in the removal of the violator from the firing line and possibly dismissal from the event.

Everyone at a Pistols and Pearls Society shooting event has the responsibility to follow these range rules. Everyone attending a Pistols and Pearls Society shooting event also has the responsibility to bring any observed violations of any of these rules to the attention of the instructor or the range officer.

We are guests at the ranges used by Pistols and Pearls Society for these shooting events; it is everyone's individual responsibility to clean up after themselves. We always want to leave the range cleaner and better than when we arrived.

Range Rules:

- 1. Treat all firearms as if they were loaded at all times.
- 2. Keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you are on target and have decided to shoot.
- 3. Do not point the muzzle at anyone or anything you are not willing to shoot.
- 4. Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.
- 5. A hat with brim, ear and eye protection are required to be worn at all times while shooting at the range.
- 6. When you pick up a firearm, keep your finger off the trigger, point the muzzle in a safe direction, open the action and check both visually and physically to see that it is unloaded.
- 7. Never give or take a firearm from anyone unless the action is open for inspection.
- 8. Always inspect all firearms both visually and physically when receiving from anyone, even if you just saw them unload it.
- 9. Only load, reload or unload your firearm after taking a position on the firing line and commanded to do so by the instructor.
- 10. Keep all firearms pointed down range at all times.
- 11. Never draw a handgun from a holster on the range unless instructed to do so.

- 12. Never draw or re-holster a handgun with your finger in the trigger guard or on the trigger.
- 13. Always wash hands and face in cold water after leaving the range and shower and change clothing at the end of a shooting day to reduce the possibility of lead contamination. Wash range clothes separate from family clothes.
- 14. Never go forward from the firing line unless your handgun is safely holstered, and the instructor directs you to do so.
- 15. Never step back from the firing line unless your handgun is safely holstered, and the instructor directs you to do so.
- 16. While on the firing line, never bend over to retrieve dropped articles until instructed to do so.
- 17. No talking on the firing line unless to or with the instructor.
- 18. Pay strict attention to the instructor and the range safety officer.
- 19. Never anticipate a command. When in doubt, raise your non-shooting hand.
- 20. Never permit the muzzle of a firearm to touch the ground.
- 21. Conduct proper safety inspection of all weapons before and after all training sessions.
- 22. Never dry fire a firearm on the range unless instructed to do so.
- 23. You are expected to use good judgment and to refrain from attempting any exercise which you may not be able to perform safely, based on your own ability, equipment, prior training or physical condition.
- 24. Eye protection must be worn while cleaning any firearm.
- 25. No alcohol or mentally or physically altering drugs will be used at the range.
- 26. Anyone can call for a cease fire on the firing line at any time for any reason.
- 27. If the range class has already started, any member who arrives late and has not notified the President, in advance, may observe but may not participate on range for the duration of that class.
- 28. In addition to these range rules, all range rules for the private range we use will be followed.
- 29. REMEMBER: Everyone has the responsibility for range safety.
